Being a Christ Centered Community

In our 1/5/2025 service we reviewed the JourneyEC Vision Statement –

"To be a growing Christ-centered community that glorifies God and loves people"

and focused on the phrase "Christ-centered community". Why does it say community rather than church?

The word, church, has a lot of different meanings as it can be a place/geographic location, it can be an event, it can be a congregation, it can be an entity, and in some ways, can even be used as a verb! We want to focus on the community part of "church".

To be a community means that we are a part of one another-one body in Christ. And we care for one another. We rejoice when others rejoice, and we are sad when others are saddened. A Christ-centered community is a 24-7 way of living. It is the interaction between Christians at JourneyEC on a day-to-day basis. It is about being a part of each other's lives.
