How Are We to Understand the "Kingdom of God?" (Part 1)

Unlike European countries, the citizens of the United States do not have a king. That's exactly what he founders of the U.S. were staying away from...a dictatorial king who did not allow representation.

Christians have a benevolent king, Jesus Christ. On a number of occasions, Jesus is referred to as a king in temporal (political) and future (salvation) terms. In the New Testament, it is mainly used in the context of a question, challenge or misunderstanding. For example, Pilate asked Jesus "Are you the king of the Jews?" and later had the sign above the cross declare "Jesus of Nazareth, the King of the Jews."

When Jesus realized that the people were seeking to make him king, he withdrew to the mountain in John 6:15. There seemed to be an overemphasis among the Jewish people in that day that focused on the temporal nature of the king rather than the spiritual aspects and benefits of Jesus's kingly ministry.

That leads us to the kingdom of God, sometimes also referred to as "the kingdom of heaven," "the kingdom" or "your kingdom." These terms express a broad range of ideas and spiritual principles that collectively provide an idea as to the nature and characteristics of God's kingdom and rule.
