Intentional Acts of Kindness By Phil Jen Kin

My son, Chris, sent me this text recently. An amazing story of blessings: "We went into a local cafe that was too crowded with nowhere to sit. The employees that work there made an extra effort to find us a seat. I told Matty (our 12 yr. old grandson) that because I always treat everyone there with respect, even down to the guy whose sole job is to wipe tables, they in turn appreciate the acknowledgement, and do what they can to return the favor. Matty processed this and understood. At the end of our meal, the man who wiped tables overheard that it was Matty's birthday and gave him \$20. Despite our insistence, he

wouldn't take the money back. Matty understood the employee is likely to be not very well off, and that this was not a small gesture. Matty was a little teary eyed. God gave him a very timely lesson (in kindness) for his birthday today."

As a father of a middle-aged son, I was very proud of Chris using this occasion as a teachable moment for Matty with a real time example of how simple acts of kindness can produce great results. No matter the color of your skin, or the socioeconomic position you possess, God asks us to treat everyone with kindness, dignity, and love. Ephesians 4:32 says, "Instead,

be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you."

Random acts of kindness can be better expressed as "intentional acts of kindness". In the name of Jesus these kind acts are guaranteed to bless others, and to glorify the Lord. Proverbs 19:17 says, "Whoever is kind to the poor lends to the Lord, and he will reward them for what they have done."

In 2025, let's be intentional about intentional acts of kindness. We are blessed to be a blessing to others. Amen?
