# **GO Partner Update**

What a blessing it was for the church when GO Partners, E and T, shared about their life journey at the Women's Fall Brunch and at Family Bible Hour in September.

After 1st serving in Turkey for over 25 years, where they lived in a lower-class neighborhood to share the good news with their friends and neighbors and led a churchplanting team, the 2nd part of their journey led them to serving on their organization's regional leadership team for the next 5 years, overseeing teams in 5 countries (Turkey, Albania, Kosovo, Macedonia and Bosnia).

Then from 2020 to present, their latest journey has E and T with

international leadership responsibilities that includes strategic planning, leadership training and mentoring. In August 2023, T shared how she was ready to retire after 30 years in the field, but that God had different plans for her. T was then appointed as the first woman and the first person of color of their organizations to serve on the International Director Team (CEO equivalent). E continues in his role in leadership training and development.

Thank you, Journey Church and JEC prayer partners Sonshine Ladies Hug Group and FV Hug Group, for your continued prayers and support for E and T and their

work and for the wonderful time of fellowship during their visit to JEC.

Please pray for T and the International Director Team as they monitor the situation in Leban@n. There are over 30 personnel there, some of whom have been evacuated out of the south of the country to the north; the decisions remain as to whether there will be a full evacuation out of the country. Pray for the Lord's protection of people and peace for that country and region.
