Sermon Notes – Light of Lights, Gift of Gifts, King of Kings

John 1:1-3;14 | In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was with God in the beginning. ³ Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.... ¹⁴ The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Christmas Unwraps the Uniqueness of Mary's Baby Boy

1. HE'S THE LIGHT OF LIGHTS
In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has **not overcome** it. **John 1:4-5**

The **true light** that gives light to everyone was coming into the world. He was in the world, and though the world was made through him, the world did not recognize him. **John 1:9-10**

2. HE'S THE _____ GIFT OF GIFTS

He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him. ¹² Yet to all who did **receive** him, to those who believed in his name, he **gave** the right to become children of God. **John 1:11-12**

For God so loved the world that he **gave** his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. **John 3:16**

3. HE'S THE _____ KING OF KINGS

The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his **glory**, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. **John 1:14**

He is the radiance of the **glory of God** and the exact imprint of His nature, and He upholds the universe by the word of His power. **Hebrews 1:3**
